

# 2012 Murray River Women's Indulgence Golf Tournament

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Entrance fee must accompany entry.
2. The Tournament Committee and Mens' and Ladies Committees of the Rich River Golf Club shall have the entire management of the tournament and has the power to temporarily alter a player's Australian handicap in accordance with "The Player" at the Australian Course rating and handicap system.
3. All entrants must state their home Club and their Australian handicap at such Club plus their Golf Link Number.
4. All competitors must submit at registration a current Golf Link Card or must provide Golf Link handicap card number on the entry form. Refund of entry fees will not be permitted after Monday 7th May 2012. The committee will advise of unsuccessful entries.
5. Entrants shall be amateurs who are members of Clubs of the Association or of Clubs registered with such State or overseas Associations as are affiliated with or recognized by Association or for Clubs affiliated with Victorian Golf League and the committee shall have the right to refuse entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
6. The competitions shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the R & A Rules Limited, together with such Local Rules as are in force on the course over which the competition takes place. If a dispute arises on any point it shall be decided by the committee in charge of the Competition whose decision shall be final.
7. The committee of the Rich River Golf Club (subject to condition 6) shall deal with any dispute or protest which must be lodged in writing at the Clubhouse within 15 minutes after the last card is returned for the event.
8. The committee may in event of bad weather, or for any other reason, either shorten any contest or fix another day.
9. Competitors must register at assembly time of 11 am for Wednesday 16th May 2012.
10. Ties shall be decided by count back.
11. No player to win more than one trophy on any day (except Perpetual or Novelty Trophy).
12. Suspension of play due to dangerous situations: ONE prolonged note of siren, discontinue play immediately, and seek shelter in the Clubhouse. THREE consecutive notes of siren, repeated, discontinue play. TWO short notes of the siren, repeated, resume play.
