Reporting to the Director of Golf, the Golf Operations Manager will assist and support the Golf Operations team. You will have the ability to build relationships with staff, members and visitors in a professional manner.

The suitable candidate will report to the Director of Golf and will further develop and oversee our golf shop and golf operations team. Your duties and responsibilities will include but are not limited to:

- Managing all aspects of the Pro Shop including staff management, training requirements, rostering, supplier relationships, stock levels and control, shop merchandising, and the maintenance of the Clubs fleet of carts.
- Ensure that the Pro Shop team provides exceptional service to members and visitors.
- Tee sheet set up, daily time sheet and competition management. (Knowledge of MiClub would be an advantage.)
- Communicate via social media, email and notice boards all golf and course related news and information that might be of interest to members.
- Work with other department heads (golf course, food and beverage, accounts, marketing and accommodation) to ensure the professional delivery of golf-related events.
- Working with the Pro Shop team to execute the Clubs strategy to achieve financial targets.
- Managing all facets of golf course operations including social and corporate bookings, competitions, golf events, and driving range operations.
- Analyse and implement Workplace Health and Safety procedures for Golf Operations, complying with up-to-date legislation, ensuring they are clearly communicated, effectively monitored, and regularly reviewed.
- Continually analyse the golfing environment within the Club, identify issues and opportunities and make recommendations on how to address them.
