Members will not denigrate or abuse any of the people listed above or create strife or divisiveness in any manner.

It is expected that members will not misrepresent or denigrate the Club in any way, either in person, through the media or through any form of social media.

Competition and social play for golf, bowls, croquet, tennis and any other sport played at the Club should be played in the spirit of good sportsmanship and consideration to players of all standards and in accordance with rules of competition and the etiquette of the game.

The Club expects that members will treat with appropriate care and respect the equipment and facilities that all of us enjoy at Rich River Golf Club.

Breaches of the Code of Conduct for Members shall be dealt with under the Disciplinary Proceedings section of the Club Constitution and may result in suspension or cancellation of membership.
